

Lloyd's Flyfishing Society

Fishing Rules



1. With the exception of Nursling and Beat 3 at Timsbury all season trout fishing is offered by the Society to Members on a “two rod per fishing day” basis. If a member wishes to book only one of the two available rods on a particular fishing day then the Society will consider the request and accommodate it if possible. Should a Member wish to book an additional rod at the time of booking the two rods on a fishing day the Society will undertake to discuss the request with the fishery.
2. When a booking is accepted the Member becomes liable for full payment of the agreed cost.
3. Payment must be received by the Society before the date of the booked fishing.
4. Bookings are only confirmed when full payment has been received by the Society.
5. No refunds of amounts paid for fishing will be made. However, if cancellation by the Member becomes necessary the Society will, subject to sufficient notice, endeavour to resell the rods for that fishing day on the best terms possible on behalf of the Member.
6. Before commencing to fish at any of the fisheries booked through or arranged by the Society, all Members and their guests must be in possession of and have available for inspection, if so requested, a valid Environment Agency Rod Licence appropriate for the species being sought.
7. Before commencing to fish at any fishery booked through or arranged by the Society, all Members and their guests must be familiar with the fishery’s rules and abide by them whilst at the fishery.
8. Whilst at any fishery booked through or arranged by the Society, Members and their guests will co-operate with the fishery owner and staff, Environment Agency staff and any authorised user or tenant of land surrounding the fishery in any reasonable request made of them.
9. Members and their guests are expected to respect the environment in which they fish and show the utmost consideration for all wildlife, wildlife habitat, livestock and crops in the vicinity of the fishery.
10. Under no circumstances shall Members or their guests leave any litter at or cause damage to any fishery.
